Why The Big Event

Since 1998, I have coordinated a global food and nutrition conference, called Food 3000. Food 3000 is my company's -- Porter Novelli's -- signature annual meeting designed specifically for food and nutrition communicators, providing a forum to examine current trends, policies, and research that impact food and nutrition issues. Every year this extraordinary event includes seasoned food communicators from nutrition, food retailers, food technology and culinary perspectives. In addition, each year, this event takes place in a different city around the world to provide a cultural and culinary discovery to match the level of science and food policy in our educational sessions.

In 2010, I contracted with Rosie McGrath and her team at The Big Event to serve as our destination management partners on the ground for our event to take place in Florence, Italy. We already had many years of experience coordinating this event more than a dozen times already. So we knew what we were looking for. We interviewed many firms in the region before selecting Rosie and her team. But ultimately, Rosie's passion for our event, her initiative to understand our guests and their needs, and her ability to create truly unique experiences for us made it clear that Rosie was the best partner we could find in Florence.

Our event was scheduled for mid-February 2010. And as fate would have it, one of the largest blizzards in history "snowed in" me and my associates in the days leading up to our event. Without blinking an eye, Rosie and her team rose to the occasion to augment her existing duties with those of me and my team in the last days and hours before our guests arrived. I, literally, arrived at the same moment as all of our guests – only to find that every detail was meticulously addressed as if I had been there myself. The 2010 event, overall, was a smashing success and was rated as our best ever on participant questionnaires.

As noted above, our event moves from city-to-city each year. I was disappointed that my successful relationship with Rosie and The Big Event would be limited to Florence in 2010. But once again, Rosy rose to the occasion and offered her services in other cities. In 2011, she coordinated the cultural program for Food 3000 in Dublin, Ireland. And in 2012, she coordinated the cultural program for Food 3000 in Prague, Czech Republic. If it is possible to imagine, she and her team absolutely out-did themselves each year. "Our office, the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office in Brussels, is the official representation of the Hong Kong Government to the European Communities and its Member States. We worked closely together with Rosie earlier this year for a two-day event in Cortona near Firenze (Florence). To promote Hong Kong we organised a series of events, some of them in co-operation with the local and regional authorities. Our delegation consisted of 7 Government officials, including a Secretary (equivalent to Minister) and our Special Representative, and 15 members from a newly founded Society, whose aim it is to promote the relations between Hong Kong and Italy. Rosie was our contact person on the spot. She liaised on our behalf and represented our interests while she was also responsible for the a-to-z organisation of some of the events. Our office is based in Brussels. That is why we commissioned her to represent us.

There were two major events. The first was a high-level gala dinner for 70 persons at II Falconiere, a top Michelin recommended / awarded restaurant in Cortona. The cocktail reception and dinner were preceded by a Chinese music performance on the terrace. Rosie was amongst others responsible for identifying suitable sound & vision companies and liaising with the shortlisted company, liaising with the restaurant on the menu and rundown, suggesting head table arrangements and other logistical arrangements. The second event was a series of cultural performances in Cortona in the morning. Rosie was commissioned to publicise and promote the event, liaise with the local cultural institutions to attract a 400+ audience, find and liaise sound & vision companies, provide the MC, and take care of the logistics. For both events, she was liaising closely with the regional and local authorities.

Why did we choose The Big Event? Since I was responsible for selecting the local event organiser, let me give you my views. The events in Cortona were only confirmed at a very late stage and we were only able to send out the call for tenders early April. The events were planned for mid-May. Out of 5 companies, four replied, one of them being The Big Event. Her proposal and ideas met our requirements more than the other. We were impressed by her enthusiasm, swiftness and ability to understand our wishes and limitations. I have met with Rosie several times in the run-up to the event and during the event. She appeared to me professional and determined to do the best possible job. She defended our interests though these were not always compatible with the Italian mentality and habits. Because of the very short leadtime and our changing requirements, she was required to handle things in a very efficient way, keep the overview and not to lose control over the whole events. She had to work many extra hours and showed flexibility to do so. Our events were successful and this office was happy with the services she provided. We were above all impressed by the fact that through her network of contacts both within the private sector and the regional and local governments, which is still a very important factor in the Italian society and a key to success which cannot be ignored, we managed to fill up the venue on a Friday morning. As such, we managed to bring a piece of Hong Kong culture to the Italians.

All I can say is that the Hong Kong Government was happy with the services rendered by Rosie and The Big Event.

The organisation of an event in a place, which is not your hub, is never an easy exercise. And, finding a reliable event organiser isn't either, the selection should be based on a series of elements, ie the proposal submitted by the event organiser (does it meet your requirements and is the event organiser flexible enough to adapt to the (changing) wishes of the contractor) and how do you feel yourself about the person (do you like the way he/ she is presenting him/herself though I realise this is rather a feeling than a rational element)."
